| 3. A brief description of what the scheme entailed   | The scheme is entitled 'The Cardiology Pilot'. The service provides routine community based clinic sessions providing triage, assessment and face to face consultations with a GP with special interest in Cardiology. Clinical leadership and mentorship is provided by a consultant from Liverpool Heart & Chest NHSFT. The service also provides timely access to community based diagnostics. |
