LHCH are unwilling to provide the existing subcontracted element of the service in it's current format. S&F Health submitted their proposal to sub-contract to a new Provider, Venturi Cardiology, from April 2022, SLT approved this decision on 2/3/22; due diligence is in progress. S&F Health will remain the lead Provider and contractual requirements will flow through to the new sub-contract.
